Discussion Topics

- 1. Look at the cover of the book together. What do you think the story might be about?
- 2. What sort of character is Fifi? Think of some adjectives to describe all of the characters.
- 3. Fifi wants to be a car mechanic when she grows up. Do you know anything about this job/career? What do you think it involves? What do you want to be when you grow up? (This is a great starting point to talk about jobs and gender stereotypes. Children establish gender stereotypes early, so this book is helpful in promoting gender equality and giving the idea that girls can do and aim for anything they want.)
- 4. Describe all the different go-karts.
- 5. What happens to Hope's go-kart? Who fixes it?
- 6. How does Nathan scare everyone?
- 7. Describe the racetrack. What happens during the race? What does Fifi do?
- 8. How would you help your friends if something went wrong?
- 9. Who wins the race? Is winning important to you?
- 10. What do you think about the end of the story? What sort of message is being given?
- 11. What did the children think of the book? If they liked it, why did they like it? What was their favourite part?




A-MAZE-ING Fifi

Tightening the brakes with a wrench


Painting the car
