HOW THE BOOK ENHANCES LEARNING

Pugs Don't Wear Pyjamas explores family life and outdoor play. It teaches children about accepting others for who they are. The themes of pet care, friendship and adventure are established throughout the book, encouraging children to be kind and non-judgmental.

DISCUSSION TOPICS

Before and during reading the book:

I. Introduce *Pugs Don't Wear Pyjamas* to the children and ask them what they think the story might be about? Ask the children if anyone has a pet of their own?


- 2. Show the children the front cover of the book to arouse their interest.
 - Who can they see on the cover?
 - What are they doing?
 - What colours can they see?

After reading the book:

- 1. Discuss the following questions:
 - What did they like about the story?
 - What would they have done differently to Tom in the story?
 - What kind of activities do they like to do with their pet/friend?
- 2. Pick three of your favourite pictures in the book and describe what the main characters are doing and/or feeling?
