

## Teaching Notes: Santa's High-Tech Christmas

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### **SYNOPSIS**

Santa has discovered high-tech gear. With his techno pad, a soft reclining seat in his sleigh and a rocket pack, he is well prepared to deliver presents for Christmas Day. But as things start to go wrong, Santa needs the help of a young girl to ensure all the presents get delivered on time.

### **EDUCATIONAL APPLICABILITY**

**Santa's High-Tech Christmas** is an innovative look into using technology whilst promoting kindness, generosity and being helpful towards others. It uses many literary techniques including rhyme and rhythm.





### **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

### Before and during reading the book:

- 1. Introduce **Santa's High-Tech Christmas** to the children and ask them what they think the story might be about?
  - a. Get the children to look closely at the front cover:
  - b. What can they see?
  - c. What are the most common colours used and why?
- 2. What do they think the characters on the front cover are doing?
- 3. Ask the children what they think a High-Tech Christmas might be like?
- 4. What kind of technology do they have at home? Does it help them around the house?

### After reading the book:

- I. Ask the children:
  - a. What did they think of the story?
  - b. What were their favourite parts or least favourite parts and why?
  - c. Would they have done anything differently to Santa or Jasmin?
- 2. Ask them to think of ways that they could use technology to help around the house?
- 3. If they could receive one present from Santa this year that allowed them to help others what would it be?
